## Monthly Business Meeting Minutes and Newsletter

**MINUTES:** President Don Cople Sr. asked if there were any questions or comments pertaining to the minutes of the April 5, 2017 meeting. There were no comments and/or revisions. President Cople declared the minutes approved as is.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer Tom Clark presented the income and expenses for the last 3 months. The balance in the operating account as of January 31, 2017 was \$15,406.00. The balance in the operating account as of April 30, 2017 is \$17,820.00.

**ATTENTION:** For those members who wish to renew their NRA membership through the club, please note that the cost of an annual NRA membership is now \$30. Please read your newsletter and/or check the website to avoid going to the Range when a match is scheduled. Please take your trash home. When entering and leaving the Outdoor Range, lock the chain behind you. Wear your membership card on your clothing or equipment while at the Outdoor Range. Every member has the right to and is encouraged to, ask you for your card. The entire membership is responsible for policing our facilities and keep non paying shooters out. At the so-called pistol line, the area enclosed by the sidewalks is still off limits to all recreational shooting except to Ransom Rest a pistol. Don't drive through the fields. The roads have a hard bottom even with standing water.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Ron Bekebrede and Donnie Abbott reported on the work done at the Outdoor Range. The new concrete pads have been poured. On April 24 Bill Thomas, Duane Gadd, Mike Reeves, Wayne McLeod and Ron Bekebrede installed the turning target frames and protective steel plates. More work will be done in the near future. On behalf of F-Class Director Dwayne Draggoo, Ron Bekebrede explained how the club last year supported the F-Class Team in their quest for the National Championship with the purchase of team shirts. All funds came from the proceeds of the monthly F-Class matches for which Dwayne provides accounting. The membership agreed to support the F-Class Team in the same manner as during the 2016 calendar year.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Donnie Abbott mentioned that as of this Wednesday afternoon the crossing is passable with a truck. However more rain is in the forecast so use caution and do not cross the creek when you can't see the bottom of the crossing and the water is running high. Donnie did see some damage, but the exact nature can only be determined after the water goes down. President Cople emphasized the need to drive on the roads and not through the farmer's fields. Donnie also asked the club to consider making some modifications at the 500 yard berm to create parking for the large amount of shooters in the F-Class matches. He is working with Derrick Grant to source more piping to place in the drainage ditch and cover it with gravel. No decision is necessary at this time. President Cople thanked Jamie McKown and Mike Smith for cleaning out and patching up the back stop. The meeting room suffered water damage during the recent storms. John LeMay and James McKown are thanked for their help with the clean up. James was on mopping the floor duty while John worked on ceiling tiles. Donnie Abbott would like to have a work party at the Indoor Range in the near future. The main purpose will be to replace/restore the ceiling tiles where necessary and do general clean up. Charlie Davis mentioned that with the start of the Outdoor shooting season the bulk of the pistol shooters will practice at the Outdoor Range on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month. Consequently the Indoor Range will be closed on those Wednesdays. However Charlie gladly accommodates any new shooter who desires help with pistol shooting on said Wednesdays, as long as there is enough participation.
