Monthly Business Meeting Minutes and Newsletter

If we catch you, the Executive Committee will ask the membership present at the next meeting to vote on a motion to remove you from the club. The roads have a hard bottom even with standing water. MINUTES: President Don Copple asked if there were any questions or comments pertaining to the minutes of the August 1, 2018 meeting. There were no comments and/or revisions. President Copple declared the minutes approved as is.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Tom Clark was not present and there is no financial report. The balance in the operating account as of July 31 was \$18,970.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS: First reading for Dan Barrick and Andrew Harrison. Second reading and membership approved for Adam Young, Cory Byers and Steve Baize. The first reading for Adam Young was conducted at the Indoor Range.

ATTENTION: Please read your newsletter and/or check the website to avoid going to the Range when a match is scheduled. Please take your trash home. When entering and leaving the Outdoor Range, lock the chain behind you. Wear your membership card on your clothing or equipment while at the Outdoor Range. Every member has the right to and is encouraged to, ask you for your card. The entire membership is responsible for policing our facilities and keep non paying shooters out. Tennant farmer Sam Hagest is asking that we no longer park behind the red barn in case of high water. Instead please park alongside the road parallel to the field closest to Borden. The reason is that due to the new ownership of the house, the Hagest brothers have to use this road to access the fields.

OLD BUSINESS: Jamie McKown would like to work on the floor at the Indoor Range on September 20 and is looking for volunteers. The job at hand is the removal of the remnants of mastic. Donnie Abbott reported that the monument has been placed at its new location. In addition to Donnie the club is thanking Brian Miller, John LeMay and Wayne McLeod for their help in getting this job done. The Indoor Range will continue to be open to recreational shooting for all members on the 1st and 4th Wednesdays in June. Since the regular pistol shooters will have their outdoor practice on September 12 & 26, please call Charlie Davis at the number below to indicate that you want to shoot on this day. If there are enough shooters he will open the Indoor Range. You may bring your own targets or use the club targets for a small fee. You will have to pay the \$4 range fee to cover the cost of utilities and rent. Magnum ammunition will not be allowed. However you may use a magnum caliber firearm and shoot non-magnum loads. NEW BUSINESS: Jamie McKown mentioned that the Junior Program will start up again on Sunday September 16 and every other Sunday following. This season Jamie and Mike will work with 1 group of shooters who will have the opportunity to shoot every week. Furthermore Jamie asked the club permission to add 3 position Rim Fire Rifle to the Junior Program with practice on every other Thursday evening. Donnie Abbott stated that the storage container is working out well, but we are short on space. One of the reasons is that the High Power Targets used to be stored at the home of Wayne McLeod and they are now at the Outdoor Range in the container. He asked the membership to consider buying another container before the start of the next season. Next David Conte with the NRA-ILA gave a presentation. David is the NRA Grassroots Field Coordinator for IN, IL, OH, and KY. Following is his report. I have been working for the NRA-ILA for 8 years and have recently moved to Indiana to manage our ground effort. I have three staff members (Campaign Field Representatives South Bend, Indy and Evansville). For the most part the CFRs have been doing voter

outreach at gun stores, ranges and fairs. Last week we received our endorsed literature and now our operations are changing gears. As of right now our main focus in Indiana is the U.S. Senate race, for which we have endorsed Mike Braun. Our goal is to unseat Senator Joe Donnelly. Joe Donnelly is not a bad candidate, but Mike Braun is the better one. Do not take winning this race for granted. Apathy among gun owners during the off cycle election is the issue. Grassroots operations, carried out by an army of volunteers, have proven to be very successful in past years. Your task as a volunteer is to target fellow gun owners (fellow NRA members) with a phone call or by visiting local gun stores and talk to its patrons. The strategy is to have 3 to 4 contacts with every undecided voter. It is important for the voter to understand the positions of Joe Donnelly versus the positions of Mike Braun. This information is printed on the info card available from David. Most of you know and realize why having a pro Second Amendment Senate majority is important. As of right now bills such as the Hearing Protection Act, SHARE Act, and National Right to Carry Reciprocity die a slow death in the Senate because we don't have enough true pro Second Amendment Senators. The NRA needs volunteers, and we need your help now! Any time that you can give will help, even if it is only a couple of hours. Through phone calls and door-to-door efforts we will be able to mobilize Second Amendment supporters. I can't stress enough how much we need your help and what is on the line this year.
