Monthly Business Meeting Minutes and Newsletter

President Don Copple Sr. welcomed all those in attendance. He called the monthly business meeting of the Southern Indiana Rifle & Pistol Club to order at 7:04 PM on October 6, 2021 at the Indian Creek Shooting Center in Georgetown, IN.

ATTENTION: Do Not staple or hang any targets on the 200 yard target number boards or the target carriers in the pits. If you are caught doing this you will be expelled from the club. Please don't drive through the fields. The roads have a hard bottom even with standing water. Please take your trash home. When entering and leaving the Outdoor Range, lock the chain behind you. Wear your membership card on your clothing or equipment while at the Outdoor Range. Every member is allowed to ask you for proof of membership. Please check the website prior to driving to the Outdoor Range to ensure that the range is open for club use. Mowing will resume this Spring on Tuesday evenings with Thursday being the makeup day if weather prohibited mowing on Tuesday.

MINUTES: President Don Copple Sr. asked if there were any questions or comments pertaining to the minutes of the September 2021 meeting. There were no comments and/or revisions. President Copple declared the minutes approved as is.

TREASURER'S REPORT: No treasurer's report was presented.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS: First reading for Tyler Dowling and Bob Sobotka. Second reading and membership approved for Ted Kozak, Ron Rose Jr.

OLD BUSINESS: Don Copple stated that mowing at the Outdoor Range is now at once every 2 weeks due to the dryer weather. However due to the unpredictable weather, the time/date of actual mowing might change at the last minute, so please check the website before heading to the Range. Vice President Donnie Abbott informed the club that he made the order for two additional electronic targets for the CMP GSM and service rifle programs. The delivery time is expected to be 12 weeks. George Eberhardt announced that the CMP GSM program was turning in 2000.00 to the club from proceeds from the last month's matches. Secretary, Ron Bekebrede added that the F-Class program turned in 1500.00 in match fees for the month also. George Eberhardt Announced the winners from the Combined IN and KY state M1 Garand and Vintage Sniper championships. Several compliments were expressed about the match and how well they have been running this year with Special thanks to George Eberhardt for his work as Match Director. President Copple announced that the club would exhibit at the National Gun Day show in Louisville, KY on October 9/10.

NEW BUSINESS: Club executive officer Charlie Davis was not present at the club meeting due to some health concerns. Tom Graves was acting officer in his place. Adam Bell was present to discuss the maintenance cost for the club's website. His company has been hosting the website since 2019 at a cost of 60.00 per month (720.00/yr) to include the hosting fee and other associated costs with maintenance of the website. This cost was originally absorbed through Adam Bell's company but due to business changes these costs would need to be assumed by the club. There were no objections voiced and a motion was made for the club to take over the costs of running the website. The vote to accept was unanimous. Several members voiced appreciation of the website and cited numerous shooters attending matches due to the information presented on the website. It was also suggested that a new section be added to the website to list club matches such as the varmint matches and the Senator Martin Match. This section would include specific rules and other details specific to the match. George Eberhardt requested that club members send him photos of the creek crossing when

they visit the outdoor range in order to keep updated conditions available for members planning to visit the outdoor range. Donnie Abbott also wanted to remind members that there will be an M1 Garand Clinic on November 6, 2021 starting at 8:00AM. This clinic will cover all aspects of shooting in a CMP match and will qualify participants to purchase an M1 Garand from the CMP.
