<u>MINUTES</u>: President Don Copple Sr. asked if there were any questions or comments pertaining to the minutes of the February 1, 2023 meeting. There were no comments and/or revisions. President Copple declared the minutes approved as is.

TREASURER'S REPORT: There was no Treasurer's report.

**OLD BUSINESS:** The club exhibited at the National Gun Day Show at the Louisville Expo center.

**NEW BUSINESS:** There was a significant safety event that occurred. A shot was fired down range while another shooter was down range. Thankfully this was a near miss event and no one was injured, but this highlights why it is important to obey ALL club range rules while shooting at the outdoor range. SIRAPC maintains a "cold range" during all cease fires. This means that all guns must be unloaded, actions open, magazines removed and an empty chamber flag installed. There is no handling or transporting of a gun during a ceasefire. While the range is in a ceasefire it is imperative that all members on the line be accounted for and return behind the firing

line. This includes both the pistol line, the rifle line and any area used East of the pistol line to shoot clay targets. Every member of the club using the outdoor range is a safety officer and is responsible for assisting with the safe operation of the club's ranges. Flagrant disregard of the club rules will result in disciplinary action by the club's executive board and may result in expulsion from the club.

A reminder to club members that no centerfire rifles are allowed on the pistol line, even if the rifle is chambered in a pistol caliber. This also applies to AR-15 pistols. The only firearms allowed on the pistol line are centerfire pistols and .22LR rifles. In addition, a member may only bring a guest one time. After that visit, the guest should begin the initiation process to join the club if they want to use the range again. Violating these rules will result in disciplinary action by the executive board.

Donnie Abbott made a request for funds to purchase 6 additional shooting bags used in the vintage sniper matches. A motion was carried and approved for the purchase.

Donnie Abbott made a request for the club to provide sponsorship for the upcoming Friends of the NRA banquet in April. The club would sponsor at a \$300.00 level. A motion was carried and approved for the sponsorship.

Jamie McKown spoke on behalf of the youth program announcing that 5 of the club's juniors have qualified to shoot at the regionals held at Camp Perry this summer. He went on to thank the club for the continued support of the juniors by the club. Thanks to the generous support of our fellow members the juniors have access to eight, club owned precision small bore rifles as well as several precision air rifles, accessories and a gun safe purchased from Hoosier Hills gun club who is liquidating some of its club's equipment. These acquisitions have allowed the junior program to grow significantly in the past year. Jamie also highlighted the amount of support that the juniors have gotten from the NRA. The junior program has received a grant of \$4,300.00 this year to purchase equipment. The NRA has given around \$14,500.00 since the junior program began.

The Juniors are selling Club t-shirts with all profits benefiting the juniors. Short sleeve shirts size S-XL are \$10.00 and Long Sleeve are \$15.00. 2XL are \$2.00 more.
